

Uber-Lyft Law

The Transportation Network Company Safety and Regulatory Act regulates services such as Uber and Lyft

For a broader understanding of the law, see N.J.S.A. 39:5H-1 et seq.

For the purposes of local zoning, note N.J.S.A. 39:5H-3, which states:

A transportation network company or a transportation network company driver shall not provide a taxi, limousine, or other for-hire vehicle service, or freight service except as authorized pursuant to applicable law. A transportation network company driver shall not be required to register the driver's personal vehicle used to provide prearranged rides as a commercial or for-hire vehicle.
